

# Outdoor requirements and technical details

## The bag that went BOO!

**Playing Area.** The gazebo is 3 metres by 3 metres and the playing area is 4 metres width by 4 metres depth

**Sound.** Garlic Theatre provide their own battery operated Bose speakers either side of the gazebo connected to an iPad to be operated by the performer.  
THE SHOW DOES NOT REQUIRE ANY ELECTRICITY.

### Timings

The set up time is 2 hours including putting up the gazebo.

The performance is 45 minutes with an optional 10 minutes demo of the puppets at the end of the show. The take down time is 1 hour

### Requirements

- Parking for a small van
- Access to the site to unload
- Level ground for the gazebo and set
- As quiet a spot as possible. The show is without words with a soundtrack
- No need for electricity

### Important considerations

- Position of the sun during the show so that the audience do not have the sun in their eyes
- A back up plan for an alternative performance space if the weather is too rainy for the audience to watch.
- The venue to please provide seating in the form of bench or mats as the show is 45 minutes long
