GROW YOUR OWN AT HOME!



What do I need?

- A clean yoghurt pot or a tupperware
- Kitchen paper or cottonwool
- Mustard and cress seeds
- Water.

What do I do?





- Put a thick layer of kitchen paper or cotton wool on the bottom of the yoghurt pot or tupperware. Then sprinkle with water so it is damp.
- Sprinkle some seeds on top
- Place somewhere warm and sunny like a window sill
- Remember to look at it every day. Make sure the kitchen paper or cotton wool is damp but not too wet or it will go mouldy.
- The seeds will grow into cress in a few weeks
- Now you can cut off the shoots and eat them in a sandwich.
