Brief synopsis of the storyline

Hickory Dickory Dock is set in the Marvellous Museum of Clocks. The curators are so excited to show their amazing Mouse Clock to the audience. They are not counting on a naughty mouse that runs off and leaves a broken clock in need of a repair. In another part of town Mrs Hickory lives with her cat Dickory and is so sleepy in the morning she breaks her alarm clock. When she orders another one a huge box arrives with a squeaking sound inside. What could it be? Her cat Dickory quickly sees a mouse and chases it all over the house. The story unfolds as the silly delivery drivers realise their mistake and come to collect the repaired mouse clock to the museum. But what has happened to the mouse? Can Mrs Hickory and her Dickory save the day? Look out for a truly amazing clock and that song you all have been waiting for...

Selling Points

Hickory Dickory Dock is an original take on a simple well-loved poem with a catchy tune often sang to children with lots of laughter. The puppets and especially the reveal of Mrs Hickory's house and her breakfast routine with her cat Dickory are a mesmerising to look at and the funny glove puppets are operated with skilful manipulation. This will draw the children into the story and be entertaining for the adults.

Iklooshar studied English Literature at Oxford University before co-founding *Big Wheel Theatre Company* in 1986, specialising in theatre-in-education and touring England and Scandinavia. A fully qualified teacher, Iklooshar has trained with Philippe Genty, *Theatre de Complicite*, Philippe Gaulier, Enno Podehl and Jan Feng and has worked as a freelance actress, puppeteer and musician with U.K. Companies such as *Forest Forge, Interplay, SNAP, Norwich Playhouse, Faulty Optic* and *Norwich Puppet Theatre*. In 1997 she founded *Garlic Theatre* with Mark Pitman which has toured nationally and Internationally for 20 years and won many prizes. Iklooshar is a puppet maker and musician and performs and composes the soundtracks for the productions

Mark Pitman

Co-Artistic Director of the Company

Mark worked as a model maker before training in mime and movement with Desmond Jones and attending Jacques Lecoq's school in Paris. Mark studied object theatre with Enno Podehl, Chinese glove puppetry with Jan Feng and leather mask making with Donato Sartori in Italy. He worked as a performer and maker for many years at *Norwich Puppet Theatre* with directors Ray Da-Silva, Barry Smith and Luis Boy. He was part-time tutor for puppetry manipulation and construction at the Royal Central School for Speech and Drama in London from 1995-2003. Mark works as a free-lance director with U.K. Companies and has directed *Banyan*, *DNA*, *Nutmeg*, *Indigo Moon* and Mike Chase for the *Mask Studio*. Internationally, Mark also directed *Morgenstern*, *Around*



the World in a Teakettle and Drawing in Motion for Tineola Theatre in Prague and Sindbad for the Andersen Theatre in Lublin. Mark is a puppet maker and construction specialist and performs in the productions.

Steve Tiplady, director is one of the leading directors for smaller and mid scale theatre productions in the UK and has over 20 years of experience. He currently also tours his productions with ProTours.

Liz Walker puppetry director was the co founder of Faulty Optic and her current company Invisible Thread tours to Festivals in the UK. She works as a teacher for the Curious School of puppetry and also makes puppets for many companies including the RSC.
